Background: The Western Washington Phase I and Phase II permits expire on July 31, 2018. An Ad-Hoc Group of Permittees, non-governmental stakeholders, and Ecology has been meeting in “Topic Groups” to provide preliminary, early input to Ecology.

Purpose of this meeting:

- Bring closure to the Topic Group discussion portion of collaborations.
- Explore specific items brought up by the Topic Groups to identify: a) comments or concerns associated with specific recommendations, b) the degree of agreement among participants in the topic group *and* at this meeting, and c) those areas that may have the greatest potential for continued, collaborative dialogue.
- Brainstorm what continued collaboration might look like as we move forward.
