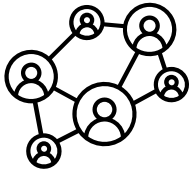

The Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to join a new Learning Network on Community-Based Public-Private Partnerships (CBP3) for stormwater management. Ecology is developing a new funding stream to support Washington stormwater permittees in implementing CBP3s, performance-based contracts, and other forms of alternative procurement in their programs. This Learning Network will bring together stormwater program managers from around the state to learn in a low-risk environment, provide input to Ecology's funding program, and build a pipeline of projects to apply for funding in 2024 and beyond. The Learning Network represents part of a broader technical assistance project delivered by Environmental Incentives and consulting partners.
