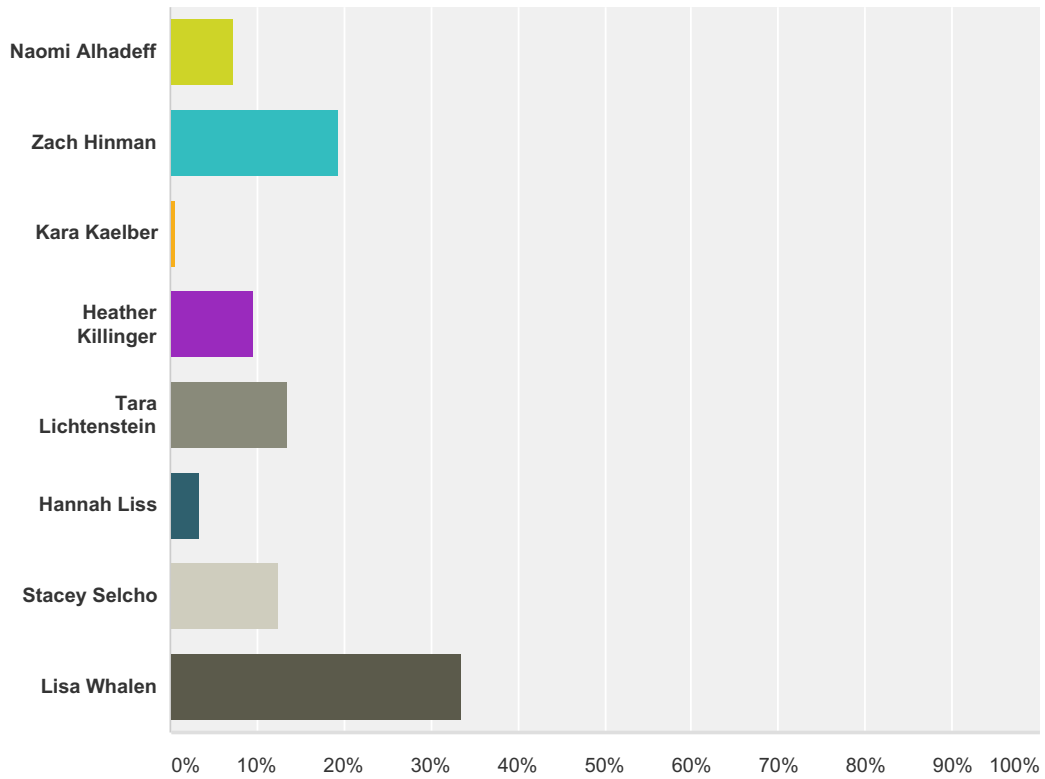


Q1 Who was your Water on Wheels Educator?

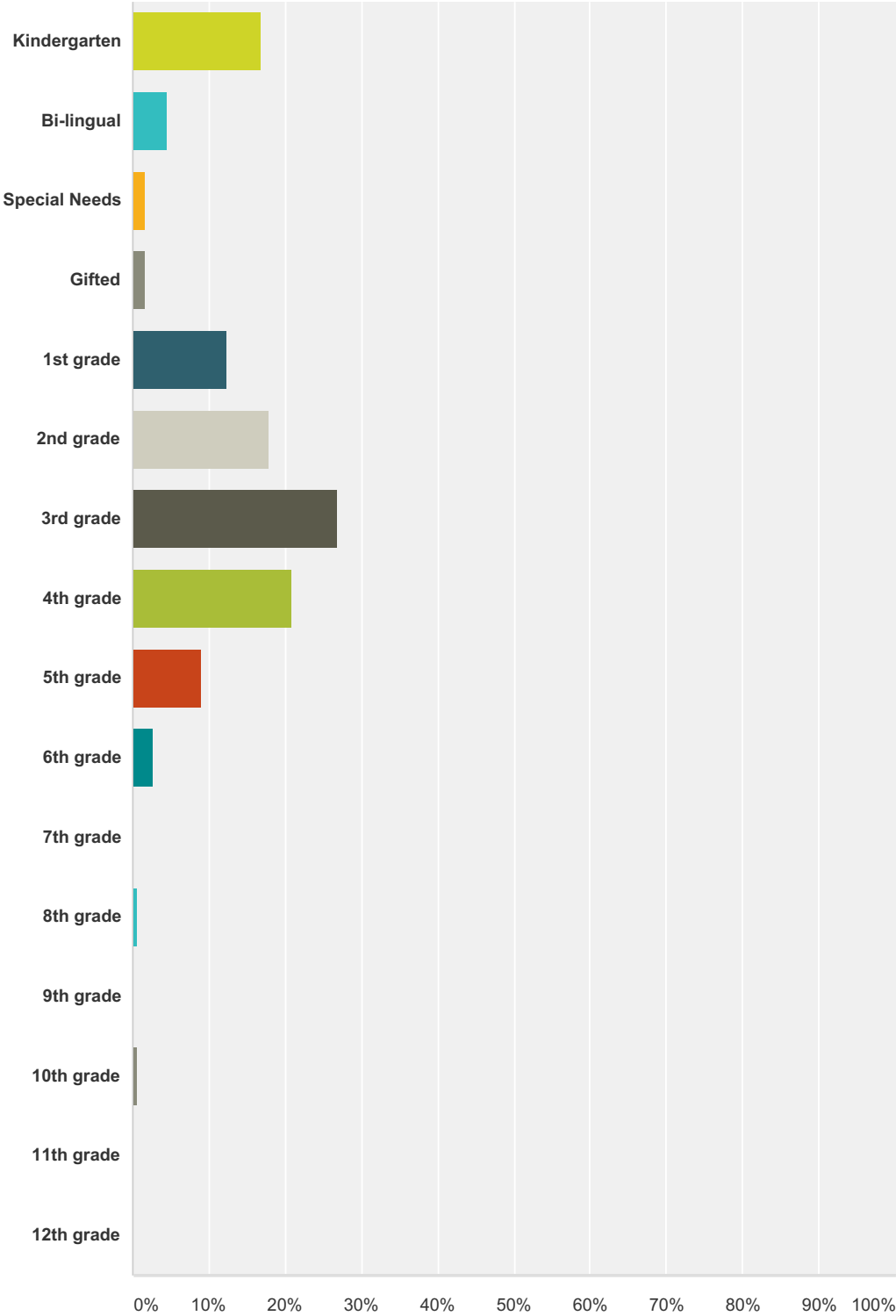

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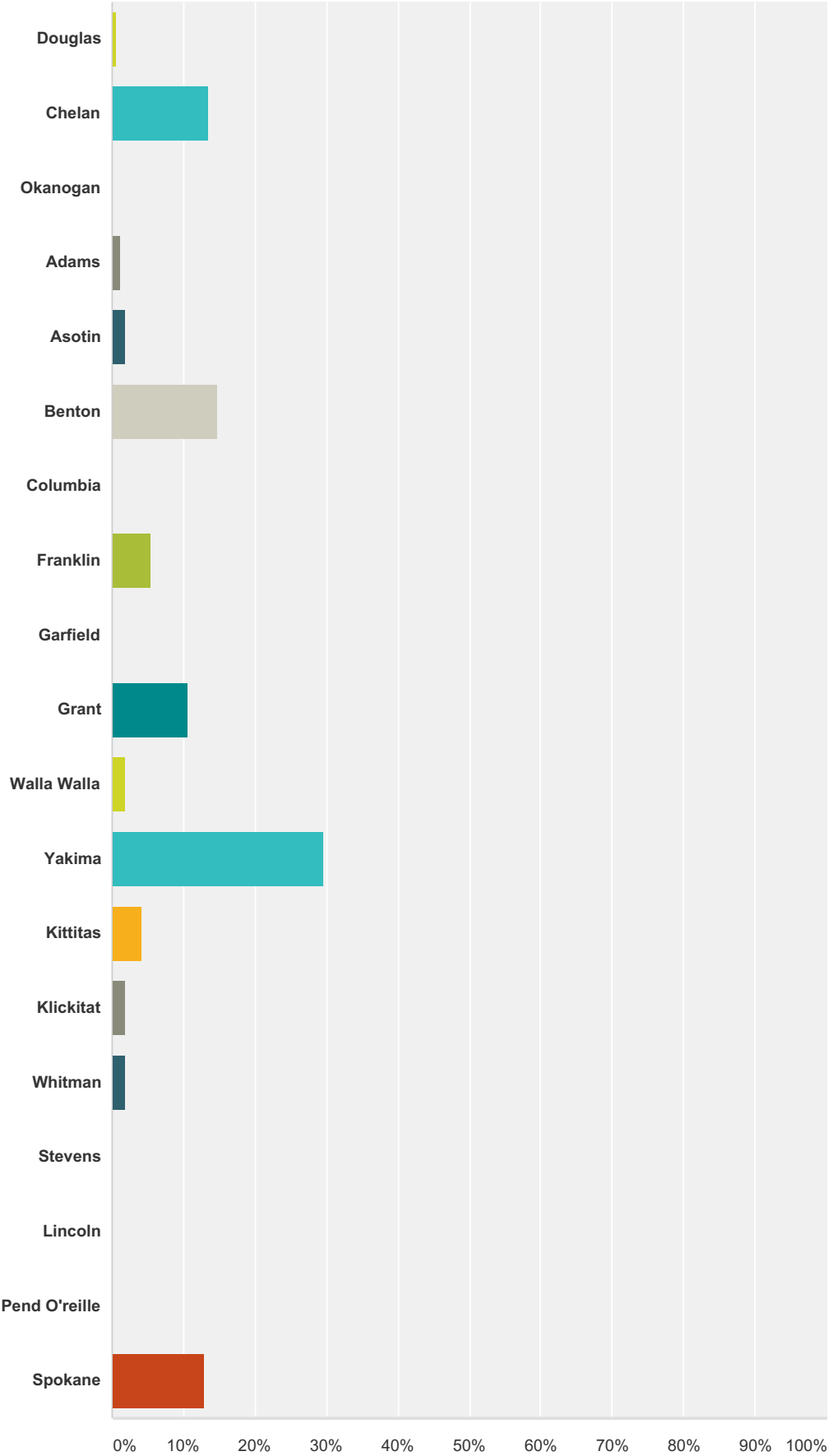

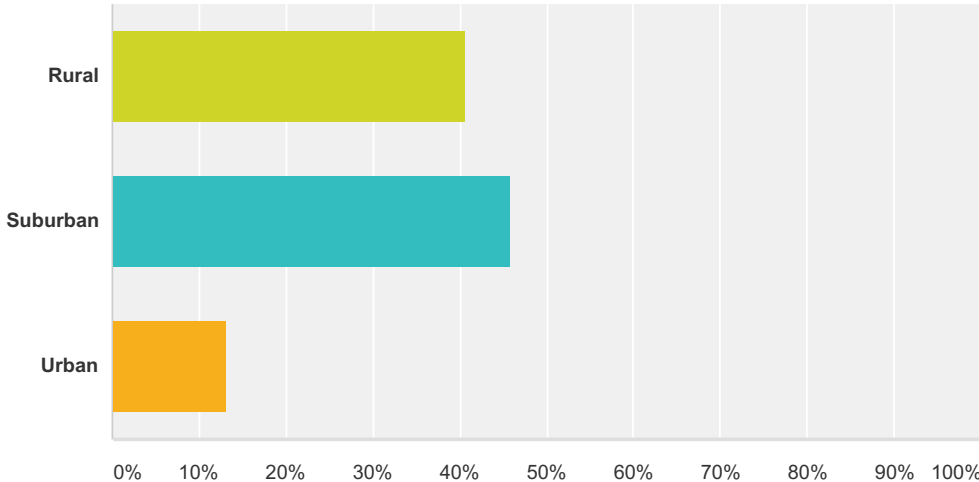

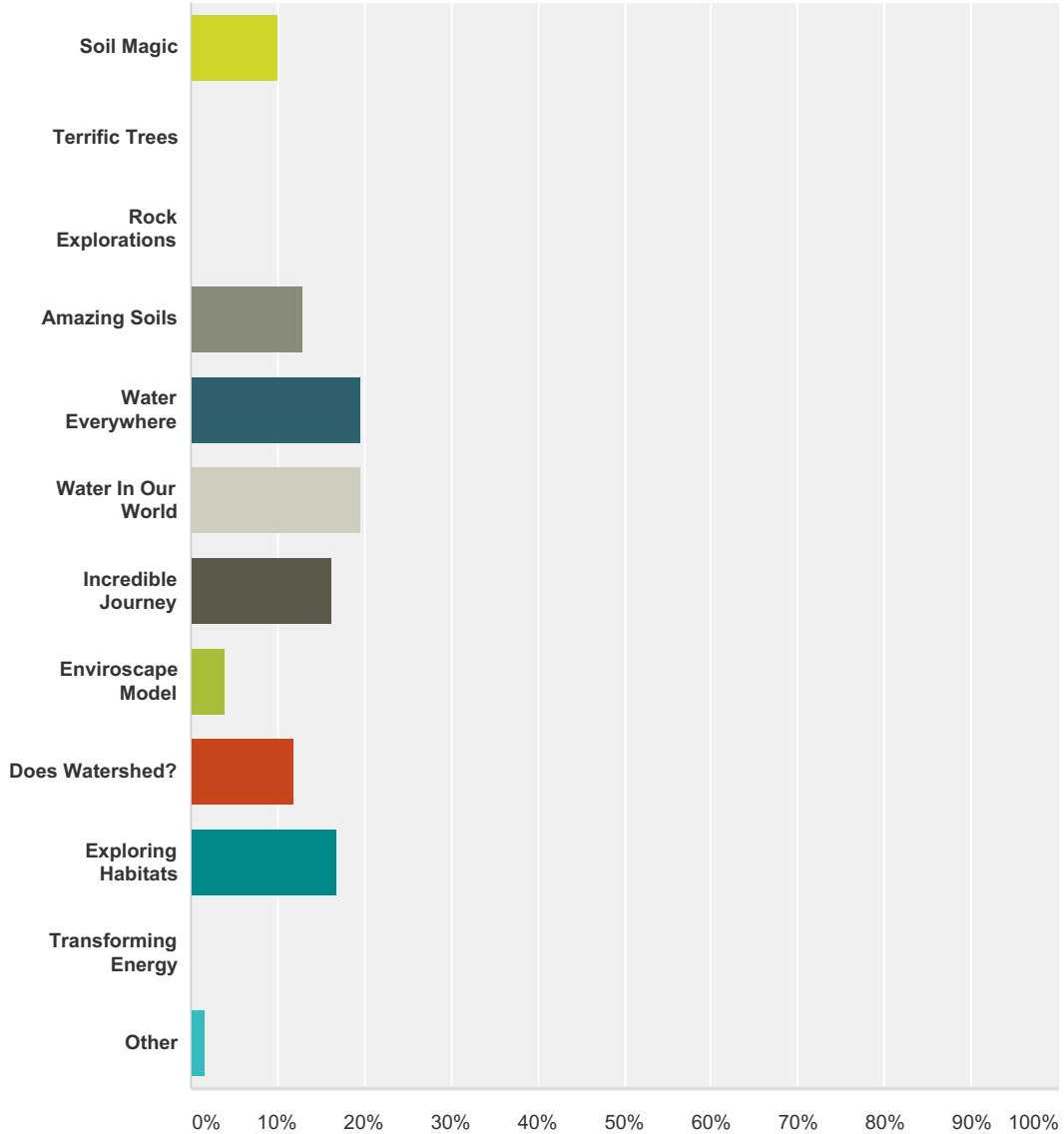

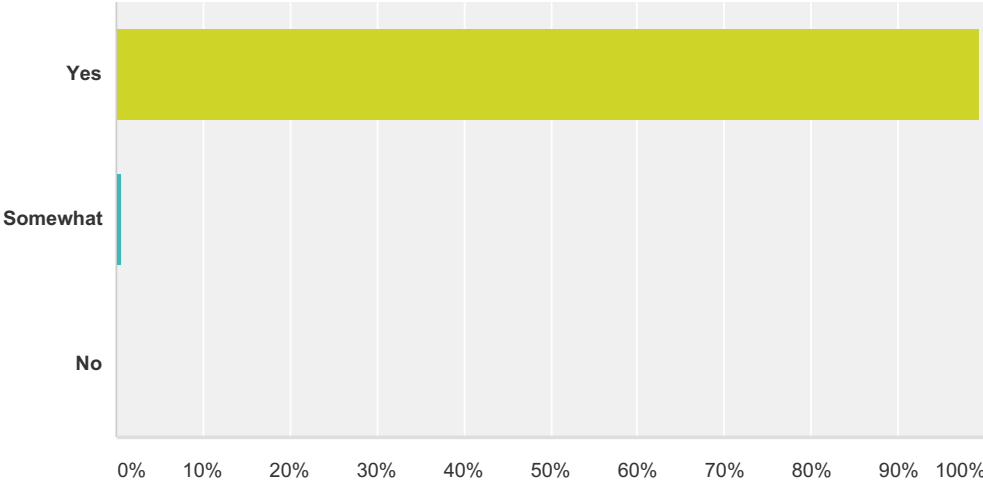

Q6 Did the students enjoy and learn from the Water on Wheels lesson(s)?

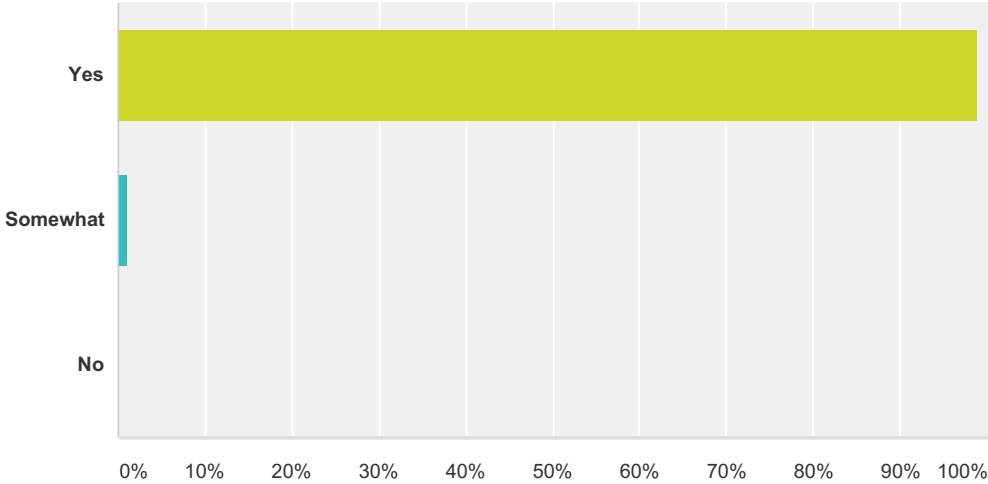

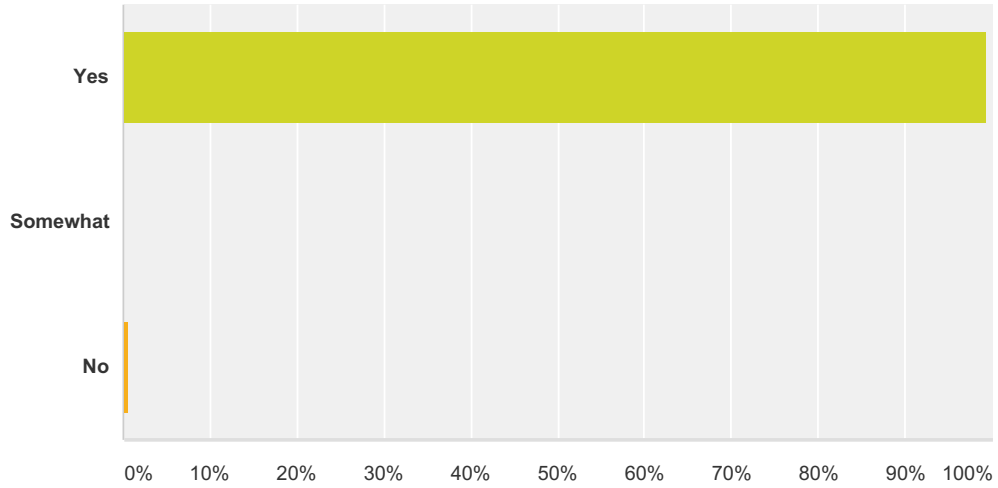

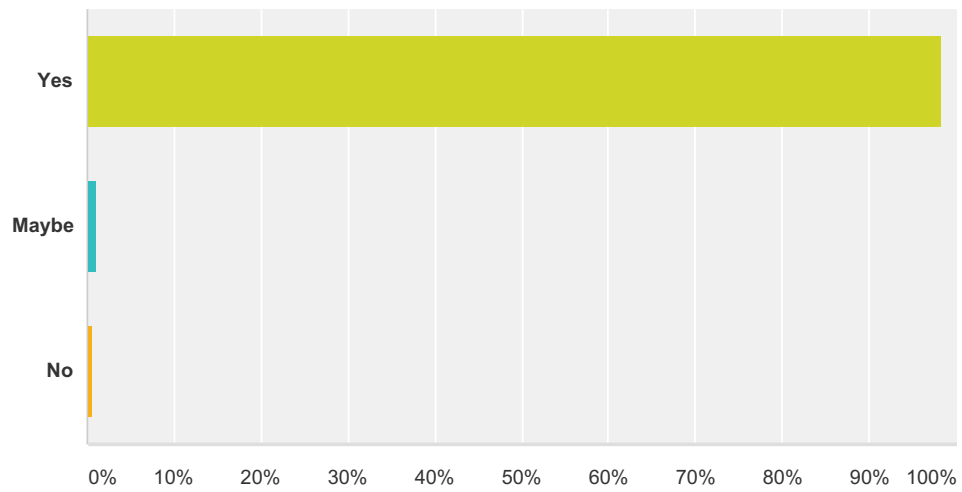

Q10 Would you request Water on Wheels lessons in your classroom again?

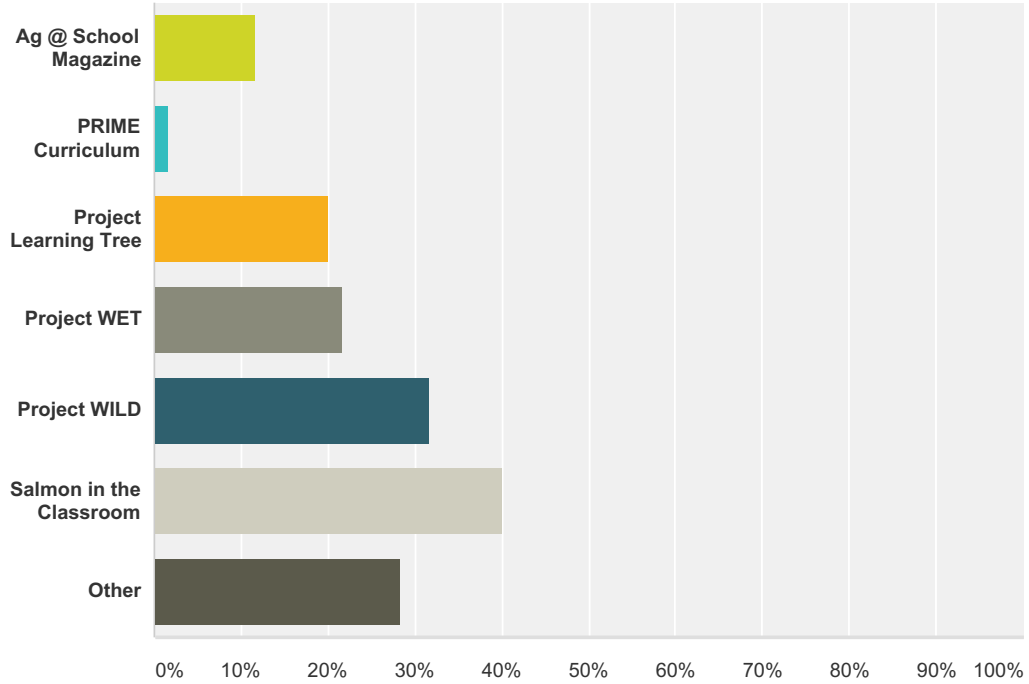
